

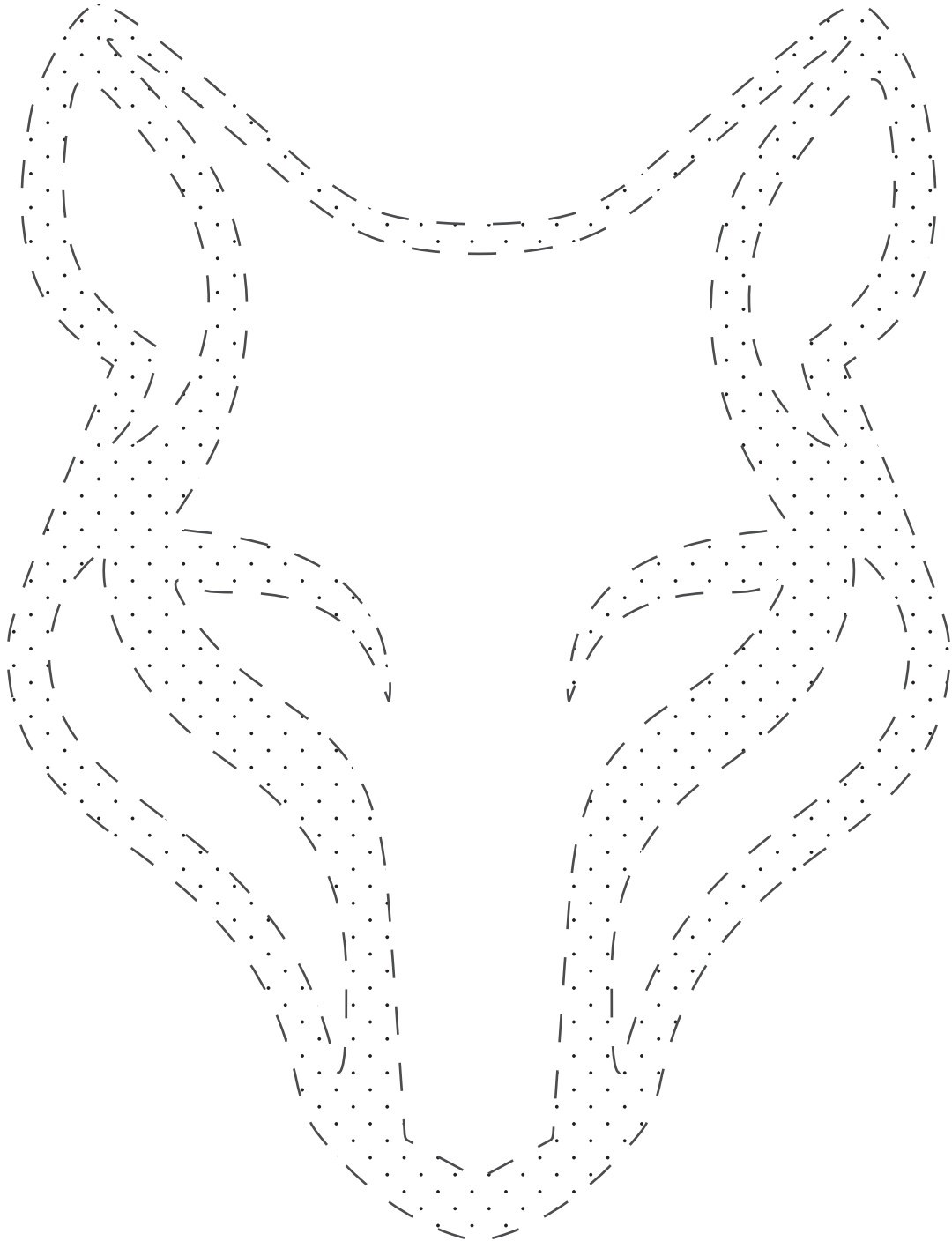

PUMPKIN ETCHING TEMPLATE

1. Print out the pattern and trim off any excess paper.
2. Tape or use pins to affix the pattern to the pumpkin.
3. Using a thumbtack, straight pin, or wooden pick, poke holes about every $\frac{1}{8}$; to $\frac{1}{4}$ inch along design lines on the edge you are supposed to etch.
4. Carefully remove template and scrape away just the top layer of skin (represented by the dotted area) along pierced lines.



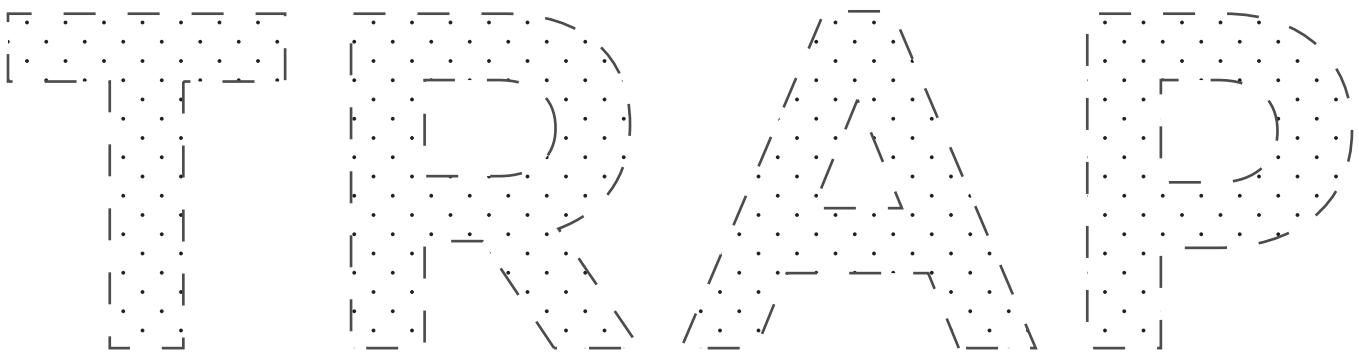
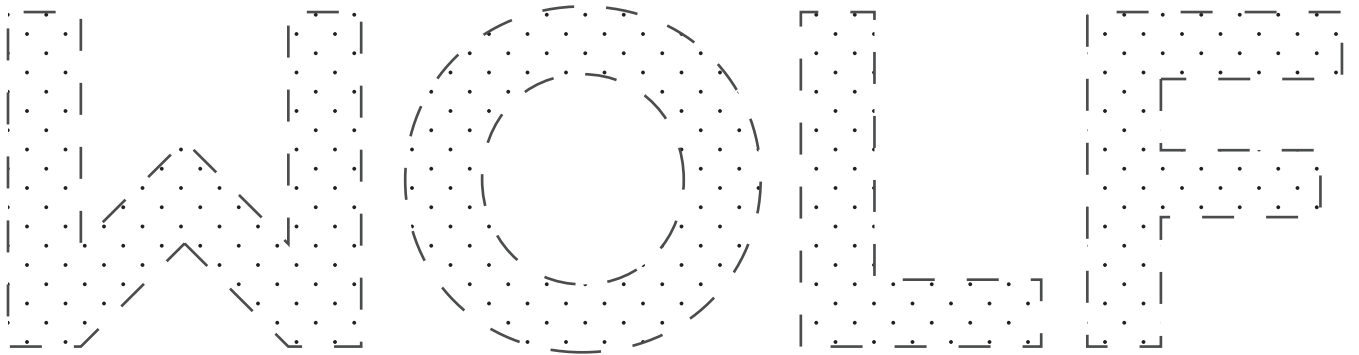


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
